

How CHAT LIGHT works

CHAT LIGHT has a color temperature of 5,500° Kelvin. This cool, bluish white light is flattering and pleasing to the human eye. The light is emitted by a bunch of doughnut-shaped bulbs (miniature cousins of toroidal bulbs used by photographers). Circular reflectors coated with a thin film of silver or white paint reflect light onto the face of the user(s). Silk or muslin fabric between the bulbs and reflectors helps to diffuse the light.

Lamps vs. CHAT LIGHT
